


Some excuses for data hugging...

The EU Open Data Portal








- Commission Reuse policy (Decision 2011/833/EU)
- All DG must publish on the Open Data Portal
- All other institutions, agencies and bodies are invited to publish on the EU Open Data Portal
- Special status for JRC
 - Art 2 e of the Reuse Decision




Who publishes on the EU Open Data Portal?

- 27 Commission services
- Council, European Investment Bank, European Central Bank, European Economic and Social Committee, Committee of the Regions, (EP to follow soon)
- 22 Agencies











Areas for collaboration

- Data, data, data....
- Tools, e.g. visualisation tools
 - Survey will be launched soon
- Information management policy of the Commission
 - E.g. upstream information management (production of data in open, machine-readible formats)
- Mutual promotion
 - Promotion of specific datasets on the portal
 - Promotion of the portal by JRC
